A YOU HAVE TO HAVE NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, A FORM OF I.D. SO THAT, IN OTHER WORDS, IF YOU HAVE A CALIFORNIA DRIVER'S LICENSE, YOU WOULD PUT IN THAT LETTER AND SEVEN DIGITS.

- Q YOU'RE TALKING ABOUT A DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBER?
- A RIGHT.
- Q SO YOU DON'T ACTUALLY SEND THE DRIVER'S LICENSE TO E\*TRADE?
  - A NO.
  - O WHAT ELSE?
- A NAME, ADDRESS, DATE OF BIRTH. SOCIAL SECURITY IS THE LAST DATA POINT.
  - Q DOES E\*TRADE DO ANYTHING TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU

    KNOW -- SAY IF I GAVE MY NAME, THAT MY SOCIAL SECURITY

    NUMBER CORRESPONDS WITH MY NAME WHEN AN ACCOUNT IS FUNDED?

BECAUSE WE HAVE AN AUTOMATED PROCESS. IT'S AUTOMATED
BECAUSE WE HAVE MORE THAN FOUR MILLION ACCOUNTS, AND
THERE'S JUST NOT ENOUGH STAFF IN THE WORLD TO VERIFY
EVERYTHING. SO IT GOES INTO A DATABASE THAT'S POPULATED
ELSEWHERE, AND IT WILL KICK BACK, FOR EXAMPLE, SOMETHING
THAT DOESN'T MATCH OR SOMETHING THAT IS SUGGESTIVE OF
IDENTITY THEFT, OR IF SOMEBODY TURNS UP ON THE OFAC LIST,
SUCH AS A MONEY LAUNDERER OR TERRORIST. SINCE 2001
FINANCIAL SECURITY LAWS ARE MUCH STRONGER. THEY'RE STILL
NOT FOOLPROOF, BUT THEY LED TO THE CREATION OF A BUNCH OF

DIFFERENT DATABASES THAT GET PINGED WITH INFORMATION THAT IS PROVIDED, PARTICULARLY BY CUSTOMERS OF ONLINE COMPANIES.

Q SO THEY'RE -- YOU SAID IT'S NOT FOOLPROOF.

THERE ARE STILL WAYS TO ACCOMPLISH I.D. THEFT,

NOTWITHSTANDING E\*TRADE'S BEST EFFORTS?

A OF COURSE.

Q NOW, WHEN SOMEBODY OPENS A NEW BANK ACCOUNT WITH E\*TRADE, HOW IS THE BANK ACCOUNT FUNDED?

A ALTHOUGH YOU CAN WALK INTO A BRANCH AND GIVE A CHECK, TYPICALLY BECAUSE SOMEBODY IS ALREADY ONLINE, THEY SET UP A QUICK TRANSFER, WHICH IS YOU GIVE YOUR EXISTING BANK OR BROKERAGE ACCOUNT INFORMATION, AND IT IS LINKED TO YOUR NEW ACCOUNT, AND SO YOU THEN TRANSFER. THE MINIMUM IS A HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR A BANK ACCOUNT, A THOUSAND FOR A BROKERAGE ACCOUNT.

Q WHAT INFORMATION WOULD YOU NEED FROM YOUR OLD BANK ACCOUNT TO TRANSFER MONEY TO YOUR NEW BANK ACCOUNT?

A YOU NEED A BANK ROUTING NUMBER AND A BANK ACCOUNT NUMBER.

O IS THAT INFORMATION CONTAINED WITHIN A CHECK?

A IT IS. IT'S AT THE BOTTOM OF ALL CHECKS.

MR. BLOOMFIELD: YOUR HONOR, I'D LIKE TO SHOW THE WITNESS, FOR DEMONSTRATIVE PURPOSES, A PICTURE OF A CHECK.

THE COURT: ALL RIGHT.

Q BY MR. BLOOMFIELD: NOW, DOES THIS APPEAR TO YOU TO BE AN E\*TRADE CHECK?

A IT DOES.

THOSE NUMBERS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE CHECK, ARE
THOSE WHAT YOU DESCRIBED AS THE BANK ROUTING NUMBER AND
ACCOUNT NUMBER?

NUMBERS ON THERE. THE SEQUENCE ON THE LEFT, WHICH HAS THAT SMILEY FACE THING TO START WITH, 25600, THAT IS THE BANK ROUTING NUMBER. THERE'S ANOTHER WIDGET, AND 271000759 IS THE ACCOUNT NUMBER, AND ANOTHER WIDGETY THING, 0126 IS THE CHECK NUMBER. SO YOU LOOK AT THE UPPER RIGHT-HAND COLUMN, IT SHOULD SAY 0126, DEPENDING ON THE PRINTING CONVENTION.

Q SO IF SOMEBODY IS SETTING UP AN E\*TRADE ACCOUNT
AND THEY HAVE A ROUTING NUMBER AND ACCOUNT NUMBER, NOT OF
OF AN E\*TRADE ACCOUNT BUT OF ANOTHER BANK, IS THAT ALL
THAT'S NEEDED TO TRANSFER MONEY FROM ONE ACCOUNT TO
ANOTHER?

A IT IS.

Q I MEAN, IN THE COURSE OF YOUR EMPLOYMENT, ARE
YOU AWARE OF ANY SECURITY PROCEDURES BY THE OTHER BANK TO
STOP THAT FROM HAPPENING WITHOUT FURTHER VERIFICATION?

A NO, BECAUSE THERE'S A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CLEARING HOUSE, NATIONAL CLEARING HOUSE ASSOCIATION.

BANKS PARTICIPATE IN IT. AND WHAT IT DOES IS IT REGULATES THE ELECTRONIC TRANSFER OF MONEY SO THAT YOU CAN, I THINK INITIALLY SO THAT YOU CAN TRANSFER MONEY FROM YOUR OWN ACCOUNTS, BUT NOW THEY'VE MADE IT SO THAT IF I WANTED TO TRANSFER MONEY TO YOU OR TO MY MOM OR SOMETHING, YOU CAN DO IT PRETTY READILY. IT HAS A PULL-BACK PROVISION SO

Q ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH E\*TRADE'S PROCEDURES WITH DEALING WITH ACCOUNTS THAT SHOW INDICATIONS THAT FRAUD MIGHT HAVE OCCURRED?
